Special note regarding weights attached to your brake drums.

Prior to installing your new set of wheels, please check your brake drums to determine if you have weights attached as shown in the below photographs. If you do, it is possible that your new wheel will not seat or fit properly on the brake drum. Worse yet, if the lug nuts are tightened with the weights in place, it could damage or even bend your wheel.

The solution is simple! Remove the weights by carefully pulling them off with pliers or by using a grinder and grinding them off, if you can't remove them with pliers. Please be careful not to harm your brake drum in the process. Save the removed weights if you can, in the event you should ever need them. Removing the weights will not disturb the performance of your special car with our wheels installed.
